BA degree candidates need to show **language proficiency**. Students can fulfill the requirement by either having transfer credit for language at the 112 level at Fisher (102 level at MCC), taking course(s) at Fisher to complete at the 112 level or by taking a language proficiency test through the department of Modern Languages at Fisher that demonstrates proficiency at the 112 level. The proficiency test does not result in academic credit, as this is not a credit requirement. Transfer coursework will result in academic credit.

Grade Point Average: 2.0 GPA required for admission consideration to St. John Fisher University. Student must submit formal transfer application available at <http://go.sjf.edu/transfer> the semester before intended enrollment.
