English: Choose up to 2 ENG courses

Social Studies: Choose 2 courses from the following courses: HIS, SOC, ECO, POS, GEG

Mathematics: Choose 2 courses from the following courses: Math 104 and above, (except MAT 118, 121, 122)

Science: Choose 2 courses from the following courses: BIO; CHEM; GEO; PHY; SCI

Students should choose one concentration/major in a content area and complete all courses as listed. Students must complete at least half of their intended concentration/major at Fisher. The Inclusive Adolescence Education degree program is a dual certification program comprised of the Inclusive Adolescence Education major and a content area concentration/major. The program results in certification in Adolescence Education (grades 7–12) in the chosen content area and Students with Disabilities (grades 7–12) Generalist with the option to add Middle School Extension (grades 5–6) in the content area. This program is designed to prepare candidates to teach in one of the following disciplines at the middle and adolescence levels (grades 7–12 or grades 5-12): Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Mathematics, Social Studies, English, and Spanish. In addition, candidates earn certification to teach students with disabilities in grades 7–12 as a Generalist. A Generalist is certified for employment as a supporting teacher for students with disabilities in content areas other than the candidate’s major area of study.

American Studies	Choose up to six courses from the following with no more than two courses from each of the following three groupings: 1. ECO 203, 204; POS 100; SOC 203. 2. ENG 221, 222. 3. HIS 105, 106, 107.
Biology	BIO 151, 152; CHE 171, 172; MAT 118 or 151
Chemical Education	CHE 171, 172, 205, 206
English Literature	Choose three courses from: ENG 221, 222, 223, 224; and one 200 level ENG literature courses.
History	HIS 103, 104, 105, 106, one additional HIS course from the following: HIS 207, 208, 209, 212, 213, 223, 224, 261
Mathematics	MAT 161, 162, 263, 241, 251, 264.
Spanish	SPA 101, 102, 201, 202. One course in another language
Physics	MAT 161, 162; PHY 103 & 104.

NOTE: Grade of C or higher required in all courses used toward Education major and NYS Content Core required by St. John Fisher. Cumulative GPA of 2.75 or higher required for continuation at Fisher. Students must complete at least half of their intended major/concentration at Fisher. The second content area major may require candidates to complete more than the minimum 120 credits required for degree completion.
