Students should choose one major and complete as many recommended courses below as needed to fulfill program elective requirements. St. John Fisher University requires students to take a minimum of one-half of the major courses at St. John Fisher University. Please contact an admissions counselor at Fisher for specific major requirements.

American Studies - BA	Choose up to six courses from the following with no more than two courses from each of the following three groupings: 1. ECO 203, 204; POS 100; SOC 203. 2. ENG 221, 222. 3. HIS 105, 106, 107.
Biology - BA/BS	BIO 151, 152; CHE 171, 172; MAT 151
Chemistry - BA/BS	CHE 171, 172, 205, 206; MAT 161, 162, 263, 264; PHY 103 & 104.
Computer Science - BS	CSC 111, 112, 162, 211, 255, 264; MAT 161, 162, 251; PHI 107
Criminology/Criminal Justice - BA	CRJ 101, 201, 203, 206, 220
Statistics - BA	MAT 151, 152, 161, 162, 263, 241
Economics - BA	ECO 203, 204; MAT 151.
English - BA	Choose three courses from: ENG 221, 222, 223, 224; and one 200 level ENG course.
History - BA	HIS 103, 104, 105, 106, one additional HIS course from the following: HIS 207, 208, 209, 212, 213, 223, 224, 261
International Studies - BA	ECO 203; HIS 104; POS 201; language proficiency through the intermediate level in order to start at the 200 level at St. John Fisher (101-104).
Legal Studies - BA	Recommended: POS 100
Mathematics - BA/BS	MAT 161, 162, 263, 241, 251, 264.
Modern Language - BA	SPA 101, 102, 201, 202. One course in another language
Physics - BA	MAT 161, 162, 263, 264; PHY 103 & 104.
Physics - BS	MAT 161, 162, 263, 264; PHY 103 & 104. Choose one of the following sequences: BIO 151, 152/CHE 171, 172
Political Science - BA	POS 100, 198, 201, 214.
Public Health - BA/BS	BIO 205, MAT 118 or 151, PSY 210, Spanish
Psychology - BA/BS	MAT 151; PSY 103, 204, 205, 206, 207, 208, 210. One PHL and Natural Science course each.
Sociology - BA	SOC 103, 183, 203, 204, 207, 209, 211, 213, 214, 215.
Sustainability - BA	ECO 204, BIO 131,L,

BA degree candidates need to show *language proficiency*. Students can fulfill the requirement by either having transfer credit for language at the 112 level at Fisher (102 level at cc), taking course(s) at Fisher to complete at the 112 level or by taking a language proficiency test through the department of Modern Languages at Fisher that demonstrates proficiency at the 112 level. The proficiency test does not result in academic credit, as this is not a credit requirement. Transfer coursework will result in academic credit.

Recommended: Fulfill remainder of associate degree requirements. Choose courses in the liberal arts (mathematics, natural sciences, social sciences, humanities, and foreign language).

Grade Point Average: 2.0 GPA required for admission consideration to St. John Fisher University. Student must submit formal transfer application available at <http://go.sjf.edu/transfer> the semester before intended enrollment.
