


## **ON FEBRUARY 12, 1948, Cardinal Francis**

Spellman traveled from New York City to address 3,000 members of the Rochester Catholic Diocese at Eastman Theatre. At the close of his speech, he presented a check for \$25,000 to Bishop James Kearney, Rev. Hugh Haffey, and the Basilian Fathers, the first gift in a successful campaign for the newly-founded St. John Fisher College.

With the combined generosity of civic leaders, the Catholic church, and the Rochester community, the "College on the Hill" was born.


# **THE STORY OF FISHER**
