## **NURS 498H: HONORS IN NURSING**

An honors project is required for a student to graduate with "Honors in Nursing". Intent to develop an honors project must be declared prior to the beginning of the senior S1 year. The student works with a nursing faculty mentor to develop the project proposal. The project is completed during the final semester of the senior S2 year and presented at a Wegmans School of Nursing Colloquium. The faculty mentor and the Wegmans School of Nursing Undergraduate Chair must approve the completed project before the faculty votes to confer honors.

The *Independent Study/Tutorial Authorization Form* is available from the Registrar's Office and the *Honors Project Proposal* form is available from the Undergraduate Chair.

**NURS 498H: Honors Project Proposal** 

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Credit:	Honors projects in nursing are 3 credits. The time commitment is equivalent to three hours per week/per credit throughout the 15-week semester: 135 hours for 3 credits.
