

Wegmans School of Nursing Math Competency Remediation Guideline

SJFC Students

A student who has not achieved a score of 84% or higher on the first attempt at the Level A math competency test for admission to the Wegmans School of Nursing is required to:

- Make an appointment with a Math Tutor to review the answers from your first attempt. Use the "[Raise A Hand](#)" feature in FisherLink to make an appointment.
- Notify the chair of the UG Nursing program (mdollinger@sjfc.edu) when the remediation is complete to receive approval to take the test for the second (and last) time.
- **Be advised that if you are unable to pass the second test with a grade of 84% or higher, you will not be eligible for admission to the nursing program.**

Transfer students

Transfer students are advised to do remediation before taking the test for the third time. Additional study using any book on medication administration skills is strongly recommended.

Be advised that if you are unable to pass the second test with a grade of 84% or higher, you will not be eligible enter the nursing program.
